A Note from Father Francis Xavier

I NEED THEE

It's a whisper but you can share it; many of our Parents seem to wonder, why a big number of Young Adults is no longer interested in going to church!

Let me whisper to you, Whereas the primary flight instrument located in the middle of the instrument panel is the HEADING INDICATOR(HI) also called DIRECTIONAL GYRO (DG), many modern parents and even some Young Adults think it's their freedom to choose their own spiritual walk in life. They claim, that God made it so when He put the tree of Knowledge of good and evil in the middle of the garden for them to choose, (ref Gen 3:17) and so some families or their children grow without a Heading Indicator in their lives. They, just like their parents, trust their internal compass when making decisions in life. This has given the youngsters unlimited opportunities to connect with their peers and the pragmatic world that share with them their interests and aspirations. Paul, in his second letter to Timothy 3:15, recalls "......from childhood you have known the sacred writings that are able to instruct you for the salvation through faith in Jesus Christ," which wisdom, Timothy had obtained from his Mother and Grandmother (cf. 2Tim 1;5). Therefore, let our parents know also as the adage postulates 'Aging is not lost youth but a new stage of opportunities and strengths' and so give their children the DG so that they can transition well. I hope if our beautifully dynamically endowed young generation is fully imbued with this Heading Indicator, surely no one willingly wants to crush or to lose their destiny.

Mark this too, Paul doesn't hail the Schools or Churches for the faith of the children, thus let parents in nurturing children not relegate their role in handing down the faith to their children.

Let us pray with the parents whose children seem to not have this HEADING INDICATOR, trusting that since there is life there is hope and that God will reveal Himself to them in a new way.


