A Note from Father Mike

Did you notice that there is a common theme in this weekend's readings? The prophet Elijah and Jesus, both teach us that we are all called to love and help one another. As followers of Christ, we are to live that out in our daily lives. So we may be asking ourselves, in what ways can we do this. A great and often overlooked way is to intercede before God for our deceased loved ones. Each November, the Church invites us to assist our loved ones that have passed on with our prayers and intercessions. Many of the saints lived out this invitation in their prayer life each day.

St. Gertrude the Great was a 13th century Benedictine nun who had a deep mystical prayer life. She reported having numerous visions of Jesus and the saints during her life. One of her most celebrated visions involved Jesus appearing to her and making a special promise regarding the release of souls from purgatory. In this vision, Jesus told St. Gertrude that each time we recited the following prayer, God would release some souls from purgatory. The promise of quantifiable relief for the suffering of souls in purgatory through prayer, motivated St. Gertrude and many other Catholics to pray often for their benefit. This vision and promise continues to inspire Catholics to pray diligently for the souls in purgatory centuries after St. Gertrude's lifetime.

Eternal Father, I offer Thee the Most Precious Blood of Thy Divine Son, Jesus, in union with the Masses said throughout the world today, for all the holy souls in Purgatory, for sinners everywhere, for sinners in the universal Church, those in my own home, and within my family. Amen.

Let us strive to offer this prayer daily, especially on Sundays if possible. It will help assist numerous souls on their journey through purgatory to be in the presence of God. These holy souls in their gratitude and appreciation for our help, will assist us with their prayer. This is a wonderful way for us to show our compassion for those in need.

Job Opportunities at the Parish

We have a number of positions open at the Parish so wanted to share to the community for those interested in joining the staff in support of the Parish.

Communications Coordinator- Are you able to effectively communicate across many platforms and people? Are you able to be a social media presence and have talents in website design? The Parish is seeking applications for a newly created position of communications coordinator. This position is envisioned as a part time (20-24hrs), located on site (with remote hours a possibility).

Funeral and Bereavement Coordinator-A new position on staff is being recruited. This position is part time, irregular hours and may include evening and weekend time. This position will serve as the coordinator of Parish funeral and bereavement ministry. Duties include the acute intervention at times of death, and working with families through the process. Coordinating with parish staff, funeral directors, clergy, and others for arrangements. This role will have oversight of the columbarium to include contracts, niche engraving, purchase of urns and coordinating inurnments.

Financial Clerk- This is a new position to work on site in a part time position (up to 20 hours per week) which will assist with accounts payable, invoice reconciliation along with a wide variety of financial record keeping duties. This position will work with Fiscal Analyst to coordinate the business aspects of the Parish. Anticipated to increase in duties and hours as parish growth occurs.

Safe Environment Coordinator-We are seeking candidates to replace our retiring Safe Environment Coordinator. The position is based

in the parish offices and is part time (averaging 10-15 hrs with increased hours during August and September). Primary responsibilities include managing the program for all school and parish volunteers and staff members in adherence to the Diocese of Raleigh requirements. Candidates must be able to work independently and with a focus on the safety of all minors. Organization, communication, and collaboration skills are paramount.




